Confirmation preparation is a time for you to learn more about your faith and become more involved in Christian life at Augustana and in your community. Confirmation starts at 5:50 pm every Wednesday in the Fellowship Hall and ends at 7:00 pm.

The confirmation program begins this year with opening worship on **Wednesday, September 12.**

Parents are invited and encouraged to stay through the Confirmation hour for opening worship on September 12. We hope you can join us to get prepared and excited for the Confirmation year.

There are lots of other events going on Wednesday nights, so make sure to check the newsletter, website, and Facebook to stay in touch with all of the activities at Augustana. Please also consider getting regularly involved in a variety of service opportunities, especially serving as an acolyte.

We need to receive your registration as soon as possible, but especially by **Monday, August 27.** You need to register, even if you have registered in previous years. There are lots of things to remember, so here's what you'll need to do:

Turn in the following items:

- Fill out and return the Confirmation Registration Form (yellow form)
- Return \$15 registration fee (checks made to Augustana Lutheran)
- Read and return completed Medical/Participation Form (salmon form)

Keep the following documents for reference during the year:

- Mark your calendar for this year's events using the confirmation schedule (purple sheet)
- Start planning your service, worship, and educational involvement for the year (green sheet)
- Read the final project description sheet and start planning your projects for the spring (blue sheet)

Be ready to do these things throughout the year:

- Bring a Bible, pen or pencil, and journal notebook with you each week
- Invite your friends to the evening's activities
- Come on September 12th ready for a great year!

Ways To Get Involved On Wednesday And Beyond

Confirmation: Seventh, eighth, and ninth graders will begin confirmation each week in Fellowship Hall at 5:50 pm sharp. Each session may have large group teaching, small group time, activities, speakers, and more. Students are expected to be there every Wednesday, but two absences are permitted. Supper: You and your family are welcome to join in the community supper offered from 5-6 pm on Wednesday nights whenever confirmation classes are meeting. Supper is \$6 per person, or a \$20 maximum for a family. Please remember to contribute so we can continue offering these suppers for busy families!

Choirs: **Agape Choir** is open to all young women in grades 7-12, will begin rehearsals on **September 12 at 7:00 pm**. Agape Choir will rehearse in the choir room on the lower level.
